

BAGGING ELIMINATES POTENTIAL PROBLEMS

1. Reduced Protein Losses
2. Reduced field losses of TOTAL DIGESTIBLE NUTRIENTS (TDN).
3. No protein or TDN supplements required to raise the level of feed quality.
4. Reduced loss of sun sensitive vitamins and minerals necessary for herd health, especially Vitamin A.
5. Reduced digestive problems.
6. Reduced heat in silage.
7. Chop silage in one day (cut in the morning, bag in the afternoon).
8. What you put in the bag is what you will get out of the bag, which usually eliminates the need for high priced supplements.
9. Using the bag will give you approximately 1/3 of your acres back for other feed or cash crop.
10. Bagging gives you unlimited versatility in mixing and blending rations to maximize your net profits.
11. Bagging lets you test and balance your feed rations, it won't change due to storage loss.
12. Changing your harvesting methods can nearly double your income potential, such as bagging head chop barley and corn earlage.
13. Feeding operations can be mechanized, nearly eliminating hand labor.
14. Bagging, testing and balancing feed ration = HIGH RETURN ON INVESTMENT.
